DISINFECTION OF COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS DISEASE

Agent Clean of the Quad Cities is offering surface sanitation services to help fight the spread of coronavirus. We are using top-of-the-line equipment and cleaning solutions, and our techs are trained in usage and safety.

We use a special electrostatic sprayer made by EvaClean to sanitize surfaces. This allows us to cover up to 3x the surface area that a standard fogger or mister does while saving time.

We also use San-Q, a food-safe sanitizer that is registered with the EPA and confirmed effective against coronavirus by the CDC.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1) How does the EvaClean differ from other foggers?

The EvaClean is an electromagnetic applicator that statically charges particles, causing them to be drawn and cling to surfaces. Traditional foggers suspend the solution in the air and let it settle on surfaces. This also means that the EvaClean sprayer is safer as the solution spends less time in the air, making for less respiratory concerns when applying. 2) Is there a residue after using the sprayer?

There may be some residue left over, but it is food-safe and harmless. It can be wiped off with a cloth and water if need be. We will clean windows and glass to remove residue as needed.

3) How does San-Q work?

San-Q is a quaternary ammonium solution that sanitizes non-porous surfaces when applied at 200-400 parts per million (PPM). We use testing strips to ensure proper PPM is achieved on a given surface. Here is the [product page for San-Q](#).
